# **EA CE Requirements**

# <u>IRS</u>

- 72 CE total in 3 Year Renewal Cycle
  - Minimum of 16 CE total per year in Federal Tax or Federal Tax Update with 2 CE Ethics

# <u>NAEA</u>

 Minimum of 30 CE per year with 24 CE in Federal Tax or Federal Tax Update
 With 2 CE Ethics

#### IRS Tax Professional PTIN System

This online system allows you to sign up and renew your **Preparer Tax Identification Number (PTIN)**, keep your account information current, view your continuing education credits and receive communications from the IRS Return Preparer Office.

SYSTEM STATUS: Sign-up and newal applications for the 2020 calendar year are now available.



#### **New User**

You should only create a PTIN account if you 1) prepare federal tax returns for compensation, 2) are an enrolled agent, or 3) intend to become an enrolled agent.

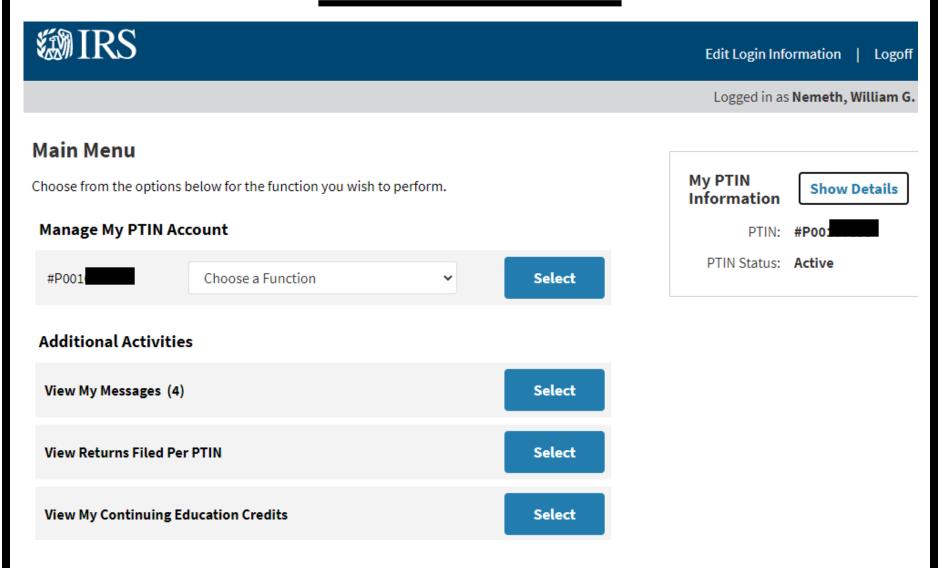

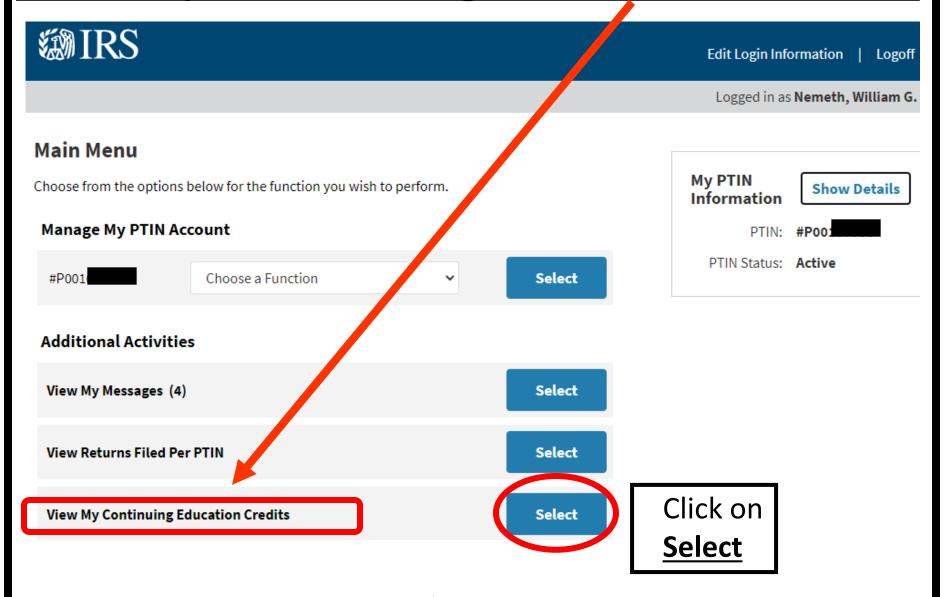

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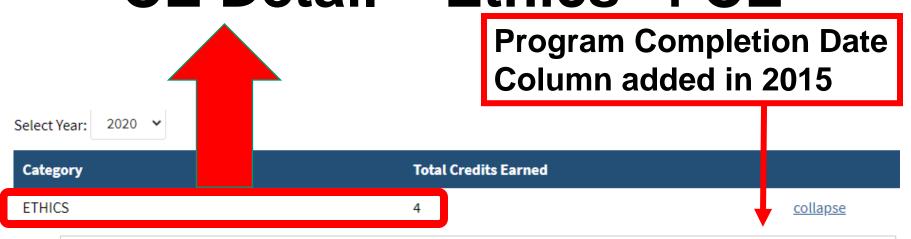

# Review your CE

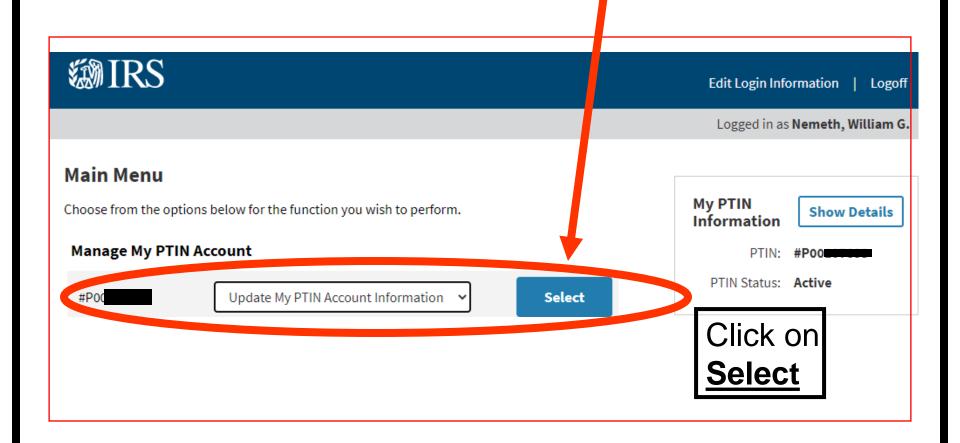
- Verify that the CE Courses you attended during the year of interest are listed.
- If you took a CE Course and it is not listed, the IRS advises you to first check with the CE Provider. If you are not successful with the CE Provider, then go to IRS.GOV and pull up: Form 14360, Continuing Education Provider Complaint Referral

Fill out & mail it to the IRS CE Office.

 Each CE Provider is supposed to upload CE info by the end of each quarter; recommended upload during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter is 10 days from completion of course.

Important if you renewed your EA License late last year
AFTER you renewed your PTIN – EA Database and PTIN
Database ARE NOT Linked Together

#### **Summary of Returns Filed**

See the chart below for the number of tax returns with your PTIN processed by the IRS this year. The data is updated weekly and includes only Form 1040 series returns processed in rough the date specified.

If the number is **substantially higher** than the number of tax returns you've prepared and you suspect possible misuse of your PTIN, complete Form 14157.

If the number is **substantially lower** than the number of tax returns you've prepared, you need to verify that you are entering your PTIN correctly on returns. The most common cause of this problem is the entry of an incorrect PTIN during tax preparation software setup.

#### **Definitions:**

- · Processing Year: the current calendar year
- Tax Year: the tax year of the returns
- 1040s Processed: includes only 1040 series returns (1040, 1040-PR, 1040-SS, 1040A, 1040EZ, 1040EZ-T, 1040NR, and 1040NR-EZ)
